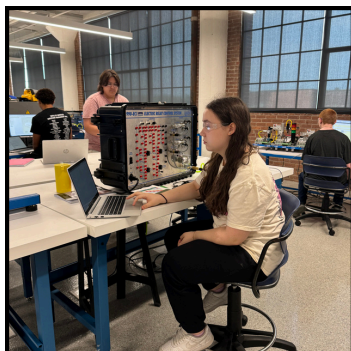

Hawkeye's Regional Training & Transportation Center (RTTC) offers a variety of transportation training programs including Class A CDL.

WE Build Waterloo: an introduction to construction trades & pre-apprenticeship program is a 12 week course that provides a foundation for various career paths within construction trades.

The Automation & Robotics Center is here to support our community (business & individuals) and address Iowa's growing demand for middle skill workers, focusing on Industry 4.0.

While employers may sponsor their employee and individuals may self-pay; Hawkeye also has two other forms of funding for individuals to complete Industry 4.0 training, SMART Iowa and GAP Assistance Program.

To minimally qualify for these funding options individuals must meet the following: US citizens (or able to work in the US) who live in Iowa, are age 17+, and not currently enrolled in high school.
